









## Conclusion

JST includes all the tools necessary for developing, deploying and testing Enterprise JavaBeans using XDoclet annotations as the mechanism for generating and keeping all the required EJB file up to date.

While entity beans will not be explicitly supported until version WTP 1.0, the session bean wizard can be used to generate the bean file and the appropriate annotations can be made.


